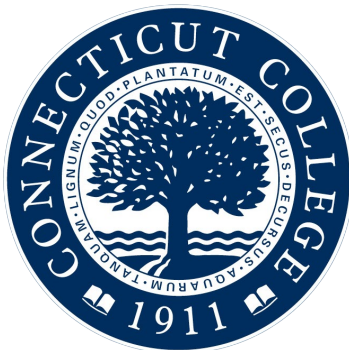
From the President

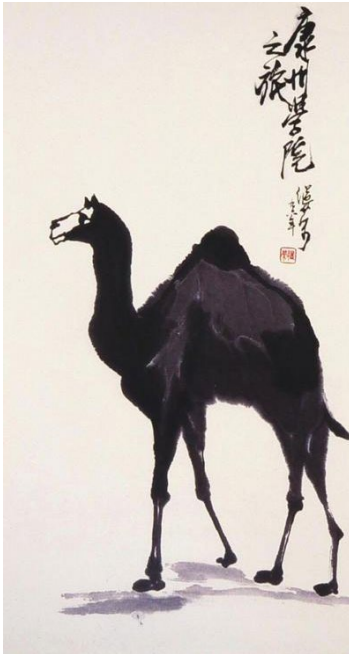


May 20 - June 20, 2025 | Camel Swag Days
